

14th Annual Mixed Challenge of Champions Tournament

Tournament is open to all certified championship mixed teams from the HCWUSBC and CHUSBC for the 2009-2010 season, and 2010 summer leagues.

1) All 2,3, & 4 person USBC mixed certified teams are eligible to participate. Teams will consist of 4 members, with the combination of any mix. (Examples - 2 female (WBA) and 2 male (BA) or 3 female (WBA) and 1 male (BA) or 3 male (BA) and 1 female (WBA) bowlers. Any championship team not having 4 members may recruit any regular paying member of the league with a minimum of 21 games to make 4 person team. **All bowlers must have 21 or more games bowled in said league. If the league championship team did not return for the 2010 - 2011 season, they are still eligible to bowl provided their membership with USBC is current.**

2) The team captain must submit entry to tournament manager with payment no later than **September 30, 2010**, this is also closing date for entries. **All incomplete entries will be returned NO EXCEPTIONS.**

3) Entry fee will be **\$80.00** per team for lineage and prize fund (to be paid at least 1 in 5). Polo shirts will be awarded to the winners at the expense of both associations. (Prize money returned 100%)

4) Teams will bowl 3 games on 1 pair of lanes, total with handicap will determine the winners.

5) Multiple participation will be allowed if bowler has placed on another championship team, but cannot bowl both entries at the same squad time. There is no restriction of line up for multiple participation.

6) All participants must be currently USBC (BA) or USBC (WBA) certified members through CHUSBC (BA) or HCWUSBC (WBA)

7) Handicap will be 90% of 210

8) Bowlers shall use highest yearbook average for 21 or more games from the 2009-2010 season. All bowlers should be familiar with USBC rule #319. 2010 summer averages will only be used if the bowler has no winter season average. Averages can be found @ www.bowl.com

9) The 10 pin up and 15 pin up rule will not apply for this tournament.

10) Bowlers who have qualified for a prize of \$600 or more in any single event in a tournament within the previous 12 months, even though payment of the prize has not yet been made, must report the actual score, prize position, and amount won to the tournament manager before bowling for possible re-rating in accordance with USBC Rule #319D.

11) The Tournament Manager shall have the final decision on all questions concerning rules not covered by USBC. Any rules not covered above will be covered by the USBC rulebook.
