



# Cecil Harford United States Bowling Congress BA 25<sup>th</sup> Annual Champion of Champions Tournament

Tournament is open to all certified championship teams from the CHUSBC BA for the 2009 - 2010 winter season and 2010 summer season.

1. All 2,3,4 & 5 person USBC Certified teams are eligible to participate. If the leagues championship team is unable to participate, then the 2<sup>nd</sup> place team only may represent the league. Substitutes will be allowed providing they are a regular paying member of the league with a minimum of 21 games. **If the league championship team did not return for the 2010 - 2011 season, they are still eligible to bowl, provided their membership with USBC is current.**
2. If the playing strength of the league is less than five (5) members, the championship team may use any **regular paying member** of their league with 21 or more games to fill the roster of five (5) members.
3. All teams must submit with entry their final league standing sheet and payment to the tournament manager no later than **September 30, 2010**, as this is the closing date for entries.
4. Entry fee will be \$100.00 per team for lineage and prize fund. Jackets will be awarded to the championship team. Prize fund to be paid at least 1 in 5 and returned 100%.  
No entry fee will be refunded if the team does not show up to bowl. Prizes will be awarded to the persons that actually bowl.
5. Teams will bowl three (3) games across six (6) lanes. Total pins plus handicap will determine the final standings. Handicap will be on a team basis, 90% of the difference between the teams average and 1100. Maximum handicap per game will be 240 pins.
6. Bowlers will use their highest USBC yearbook average from any association for 21 or more games from the 2009-2010 season. All bowlers should be familiar with USBC Rule # 319. 2010 summer averages will only be used if the bowler has no winter season average. If any bowler has been re-rated in any tournament within the past 12 months must report this to the tournament can be manager before bowling. Averages found @ [www.bowl.com](http://www.bowl.com)

7. Certified mixed leagues are not eligible to participate. Female bowlers certified through USBC BA are eligible to participate if all eligibility requirements are met.
8. Multiple participation will be allowed if a bowler has placed on another championship team, but cannot bowl both entries at the same squad time. There is no restriction of line up.
9. The 10 pin up rule and 15 pin up tournament rule will be waived.
10. Bowlers who have qualified for a prize of \$600 or more in any single event in a tournament within the previous 12 months, even though payment of the prize has not yet been made, must report the actual score, prize position, and amount won to the tournament manager for possible re-rating in accordance with USBC Rule #319D.
12. The tournament manager shall have the final decision on all questions concerning rules not covered by USBC. Any rules not covered above will be covered by the current USBC rulebook.
