She has been married to her husband Robert for 39 years and they have one son. Dianne currently works for the US Army Aberdeen Test Center at Aberdeen Proving Ground (APG) as a Facility

Manager.

Dianne took up bowling as a youth when her father was stationed at Oakland Army Base in California. She joined an adult league for a few years at Ft Bliss, TX before moving to Germany. After relocating with her husband and son to APG in 1996 she joined the APG Friday Night Mixed league. When that league dissolved, she helped in starting the Friday Night Fun Bunch league with a few fellow bowlers in 2001. She has been the Secretary/Treasurer of that league for 21 years and received the "Secretary of the Year" award for the 2014-2015 season from the Harford County Women's Board.

Dianne first became involved with the APG youth leagues when her son started as a youth bowler in 1997. She began coaching that year and then eventually taking over the league in 2005. She joined the Cecil-Harford Youth Board in 2005 and has helped with or ran the Annual Youth Championship and Regional Pepsi tournaments and banquets, served on the scholarship committee, and has volunteered at State youth tournaments.
