# Eligibility

• An individual must be a member of the Cecil Harford USBC Association prior to the tournament closing date. The membership fee is \$22.00 adults, \$10.00 youth and co-association fee is \$10.00.

# Average & Handicap

- Adult entrant shall use their highest certified average established in any USBC certified league from the previous season (winter & summer) 2024-2025 based on 21 games or more. If an entrant has no previous season (2023-2024) yearbook certified USBC average, they must use their highest current season's (2025-2026) USBC certified average for 21 games or more from any Association per USBC Rule 319a-1.
- 2. Youth entrant shall use their highest certified USBC average established in any USBC certified league from the current 2025-2026 season for 12 games or more. A copy of the league standing sheet as of February 7, 2026 must accompany this entry form. It is the bowler's responsibility to provide league sheets. If an entrant has no current 2025-2026 season certified USBC average, they must use their highest USBC certified average for 12 games or more from any Association from the 2024-2025 season.
- 3. If eligibility requirements are met and bowler doesn't meet the average requirements they must bowl scratch.
- 4. Handicap will be based on 90% of 230 average.

#### **Format**

- 5. Bowl 3 games of 9-pin no-tap. Knocking down 9 pins on the first ball is a strike.
- 6. Multiple participation (re-entries) will be allowed provided lanes are available.
- **7.** Tournament committee will rule on all protests and violations. Protests must be made within 24 hours of end of the squad. USBC rules will apply.

## **Prizes & Awards**

- 8. Prize fee returned 100%. Ratio at least 1 in 7 (Handicap Only) for the Women and Men Divisions.
- 9. Prize fee returned 100% at least 1 in 7 (Handicap Only) for the Youth Division. Prizes will be deposited into Smart #14696.
- 10. Other prizes may be set-up at the discretion of the Tournament Manager.
- 11. Prize checks will be issued immediately following verification of tournament entrants and averages.
- 12. A \$25.00 fee will be charged for checks returned by the bank for non-payment.
