49th CHUSBC TOURNAMENT RULES

1. All 2025-2026 Cecil Harford USBC youth members are eligible to participate in the CHUSBC Youth Championship Tournament. USBC Youth Tournament Rules will apply at all times. **NO REFUND OF ENTRIES WILL BE MADE AFTER TOURNAMENT DEADLINE.**
2. Handicap shall be 90% of 200 – All Divisions.
3. **Average Requirement**
 - a. Entrant shall use their highest certified USBC average established in any USBC certified league from the 2025-2026 season as of January 17, 2026 for 9 games or more. **A copy of the league standing sheet as of January 17, 2026 must accompany this entry form.** It is the bowler’s responsibility to provide league sheets.
 - b. If an entrant has no 2025-2026 season certified USBC average, they must use their highest USBC certified average for 12 games or more from any Association from the 2024-2025 season.
 - c. If eligibility requirements are met and the entrant doesn’t meet the average requirements, they will bowl scratch.
 - d. **If average verification is not received by tournament manager by closing date, the entrant will bowl scratch.**
4. The tournament will be divided into four (4) divisions, determined by the entrant’s age as of August 1, 2025 as follows: Under 10, Under 12, Under 15 and Under 18. The age of the oldest entrant on the team or doubles events will determine the division.
5. **Multiple Entries:** Entrants may bowl multiple times in Team Event provided two members are changed. Entrants may bowl multiple times in the Doubles Event but not with the same partner. Entrants may bowl in the Singles Event only once. First scores count for All Events.
6. **Optional All-Events** -Entrants must bowl in all three (3) events (team, doubles and singles) to qualify for the All Events Award. The first scores bowled in each event will be used to calculate the entrant’s all events score. In the event of an entrant winning both scratch & handicap all events, the entrant shall receive the award as the Scratch All Events Champion, with the 2nd place handicap finisher receiving the Handicap All Events Award. This award is presented to first place boy and first place girl in every age group. Winnings will be deposited in Smart Account - #12729
7. All bowlers will bowl 3 games on one pair of lanes in each event entered.
8. Clearly indicate first and second choices for squad date and time for each event entered.
9. **All entrants must report to the Tournament Registration desk at least 30 minutes prior to bowling.** Bowlers should bring their sanction cards to check-in; tardy bowlers will receive a zero for frames missed. Absolutely no refunds for absent bowlers.
10. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to correct any mistakes in average, division, handicap, or totals at any time prior to the presentation of awards.
11. Any appeal or protest regarding scores and/or eligibility must be made to the Tournament Committee within 24 hours of dispute. A foul must be reported immediately.

12. Awards will be based on a 1 in 5 ratio in each division with minimum awards of 1 & 2 in each division. All awards will be handicap. Award fees will be returned 100%.

13. Conduct & Dress Code: Conduct - No participant will be permitted to use electronic devices (cell phones, video games, etc,) use tobacco products, illegal drugs, use profanity, or drink alcoholic beverages while involved in tournament play. (USBC Rule 17d, Youth Conduct) Lane courtesy is to be practiced at all times. Dress Code – Presentable attire is expected. No hats, cut-offs or clothing with rips, tears, holes, or inappropriate language shall be worn during competition.

14. A \$25 fee will be charged for all returned checks.
