63rd Women's Championship Tournament Rules

Eligibility

1. Entrant must be a female member of Cecil Harford USBC Association. A co-association membership can be purchased prior to bowling.
2. Entry Deadline is October 16, 2026

Handicap

3. Handicap will be 90% of 220 with no maximum handicap.

Average Requirement:

- a) Entrant shall use their highest certified average established in any USBC certified league (winter & summer) from the previous season (2025-2026) based on 21 games or more.
- b) If an entrant has no previous season (2025-2026) yearbook certified USBC average, they must use their highest current season's USBC certified average for 21 games or more from any Association. In addition, entrant must furnish a league standing sheet with written verification from their league secretary as of March 13, 2025.
- c) If eligibility requirements are met and bowler doesn't meet the average requirements they must bowl scratch.
- d) USBC Rule 319 will not apply.

e) Multiple Participation

4. Multiple participation is permitted in the Team event. At least two (2) team members must be changed in the Team event. The bowler's first appearance in each event counts toward the All Events total.
5. Bowlers may bowl twice in the Singles/Doubles event and must bowl both events. Partners must be changed in the Doubles event.
6. Team captains & Singles/Doubles partners must register/check in at least thirty (30) minutes prior to squad time at tournament office. Team and Doubles line-up is the same as reported on the entry form.
7. A bowler must enter Team and Singles/Doubles in order to qualify for All Events. There will be a \$5.00 entry fee for All Events cash prizes. Bowlers are not eligible for cash prizes in the All Events category if they have not paid the optional All Events fee.
8. Substitutes are allowed when replacement is warranted. The tournament director should be advised of substitutions at least thirty (30) minutes before scheduled bowling time if possible.

9. Any bowler or team arriving after the game has started will be allowed to bowl and the score(s) will count beginning with the frame bowled. NO SCORES ARE GIVEN FOR FRAMES MISSED.
10. Tournament director reserves the right to assign lanes, to assign time and date if requested choice is not available and to adjust squad times when necessary.
11. When bowlers are scheduled alone on a pair of lanes, they must bowl as though they are actually contested. The bowlers shall complete one frame on one lane before the lead-off bowler commences the next frame on the adjoining lane.

Prizes & Awards

12. First place ties in any event will remain. Co-Champions will be declared. The first and second place prize money will be combined, divided equally and duplicate trophies will be awarded. In case of ties for other than first place, the cash prizes will be combined and divided equally among the tied position winners.
13. A team or an individual can win both titles and the highest cash prize in each of the events. If a team or an individual should place first in both divisions, they will receive the titles and trophy for both divisions and the highest cash award to which they are entitled.
14. A \$25.00 fee will be charged for checks returned to our bank for non-payment.
15. Equipment abuse, profanity or suggestive behavior will not be tolerated! Violation may result in disqualification.
16. Any protest affecting eligibility or playing rules must be confirmed in writing to the tournament director before the tournament prize payments are made. Errors in scoring must be reported to the tournament director within 48 hours.
